As Executive Director of Diversity and Equal Educational Opportunities for the School Board of Broward County, Dr. Miller championed fairness and inclusion for all students. A Life Member of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., he served as the organization's 35th Grand Basileus (National President) and currently leads D.C. Miller & Associates, Inc., a consulting firm specializing in leadership and organizational development.

Dr. Miller's service extends across numerous civic and community organizations, including the Urban League of Broward County, YMCA, American Cancer Society, and Greater Fort Lauderdale Chamber of Commerce. Recognized in *Ebony Magazine's 100 Most Influential Blacks in America* and *Who's Who in Black America*, he has received more than 400 awards for his dedication to education and community uplift.
